Course Description:

This class will explore related occupational or professional experiences in approved industry, school, cooperative extension service, or similar agency setting under faculty supervision. This is an optional credit class for participants at the 2009 K-ACTE conference held in Wichita, August 3 – 5. The course runs from August 3 to August 18. This course is available for 1 – 3 Undergraduate Credit(s) or 1 – 3 Graduate Credit(s). Students can enroll from March 23 – August 3, 2009 via the KSU Division of Continuing Education website: <https://eis.dce.ksu.edu/CreditReg/CourseSearch/>

Those interested in KSU credit are required to enroll in the course prior to attending the conference.

Steps for enrolling are available at the website listed above. Students are required to make contact with the instructor via phone or e-mail **prior to enrolling**. This will enable the student to discuss assignment requirements with the instructor as well as verify their names with the enrollment forms generated after August 5th.

Requirements for both Undergraduate and Graduate Credit:

1 Credit: Reflect on the highlights of the conference. Compose a written overview of two or more key ideas or programs you learned about that is beneficial to your role in CTE. Elaborate of the nature of this information and how it could/will impact your professionally. Identify at least one area that you feel you need more information or training on in order to implement into your professional role. This must be a typed reflection with a minimum of 2 pages and a maximum of 3 pages. Margins should be 1" and a size 12 Helvetica or Geneva font is required. Reference to the person, session, and/or program of which you are describing should be cited within the body of the reflection.

2 & 3 Credits: Additional credit can be obtained by applying the information or programs you have learned about at K-ACTE in your professional role. Once you have determined how this might be accomplished, develop a personalized proposal for the instructor to review and comment on. The proposal must be submitted to the instructor in writing (letter or electronic) by August 18 for approval. Once the proposal is agreed upon, you may continue with implementation. By electing to take this for extended credit, you will be given the opportunity to implement their proposal during the first semester of the 2009-2010 academic year. An Incomplete will be noted for the class until all materials are submitted for credit. Materials must be received electronically no later than December 1, 2009, after which time a grade will be submitted to the KSU registrar's office for posting.
